



## **FY21-FY22 Grantee Diversity Data**

This year's data includes racial and ethnic diversity from fiscal year 2021-2022 grantees with a grant cycle of more than 12 months. 155 out of 157 grantees answered the question, nearly a 99% response rate. Data from prior years' collection is included for comparison and to show diversity granting over a 5-year period.

### Race and Ethnicity of Grantee's Executive Director/CEO/President




## Race and Ethnicity of Grantee's Executive Director/CEO/President (Year-Over-Year)




\*The diversity statistics comparison deviates from last year's data by showing the data over five years (FY18-17, FY20-19, FY22-21) rather than a three period (FY20-19, FY19-18, FY18-17).

The data below shows the percentage of organizations who indicated that within their Board Members/Trustees, and leadership staff, there is a person of the race/ethnicity shown. For example, 94% of the organizations reported that at least one member of their Board Members/Trustees was Black/African American/African Descendant.

#### **Board Members/Trustees (FY21-22)**




#### Board Members/Trustees (FY21-22, FY20-19, FY18-17)




